Going into the final 2 overs we trailed by 12 runs, which meant Sophie Ford and Jessy had to run almost every bowl to draw level, they did better and we won by 2 runs! A fantastic effort from our year 5/6 athletics team gave us a 4<sup>th</sup> place finish in the Quad Kids event. 

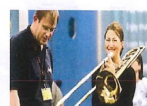
